You can't predict the future, but you can achieve it




We are now 10 billion humans.


The IPCC* with its politically correct forecasts, and its caution, turned out to be wrong of course:

In what scientists had predicted for year 2100 is already today's reality.




There were many "crises",

but we eventually ended up abandoning that word, which didn't really make sense for a permanent state.




Today we say we are "in remission" and we are not doing such a bad job doing this.






Presumably, it's set to go on for at least another 300 years*, but I won't be around anymore to tell you.

because since we have given the impulse to the planet, it's warming up all by itself.







and during this spring day, we have a pleasant

After the permanent opening of the two Arctic sea routes, the population increased considerably here.










Of course we don't
